All Rounder Scholarship

- A record of a balanced range of achievements across a variety of pursuits
- Active participation in and contribution to a broad range of school co-curricular activities
- Representative experience – at school, local and higher levels
- Leadership experience (eg SRC, sporting teams)
- Participation in a broad range of out-of-school activities/competitions.

- ii. Ongoing, committed participation in and contribution to all aspects of College life,
- iii. Ongoing support of all College expectations.

- i. Ongoing support of all College expectations,
- ii. Fees and other monies owing to the College are paid promptly.

There will be a review of the academic progress and contribution to College life of all Scholarship holders in Term 3 of the first year of the Scholarship to ensure that expectations are being met. Scholarship holders in Year 9 2022 will be eligible to apply for a further two year Scholarship in Term 3, 2023 following the established application procedures.
